DOCUMENT

A **document** is information that can be read in a linear fashion by human beings.



ELECTRONIC DOCUMENT

An **electronic document** is a document that relies on electronic media, according to software specifications. It is displayed by visual devices.

HIGHLY RELIABLE DOCUMENTS

A **highly reliable document** is a document that includes proof of the signer's identity, as well as proof of the document's integrity, authenticity and, optionally, its longevity.



1. Identity

This includes the signer's identity and professional status or affiliation.



2. Integrity

A document's integrity is guaranteed when it is possible to verify that it has not been modified.



3. Authenticity

A document is deemed authentic when it incorporates proof of identity and its integrity has been preserved.



4. Longevity

Document longevity ensures that the document can be opened, read and authenticated for decades.



EXAMPLES

Documents created by professionals: Financial statements, property assessments, engineering and architectural plans, court proceedings, etc.

Other examples of highly reliable documents: Academic transcripts, contracts, wills, mandates, birth certificates, corporate and governmental archives, etc.
